

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **What is the general process to register for the rally?**

Before registering, please review the Terms & Conditions document. It will explain some important details related to costs and provided items.

When you're ready to register, please proceed to the [Event Details](#) page, and select "Buy Tickets". There are multiple options to purchase tickets, based upon the number of people who will be attending. If only one or two people are attending, select the basic ticket for \$350. You may use the "View more price options" button to see a list of selections where more people can be added. Each additional person beyond 2 people in an RV costs an additional \$40 per person.

Once you have selected the desired ticket, proceed to Checkout, where you'll fill in all pertinent information related to email, address, check in and check out dates, etc.

## **We are arriving before July 26, 2023 and/or staying after July 30, 2023. Do we need to reserve at the resort?**

No. When registering for the rally, you will indicate your arrival and departure days. You will also be asked to check a box if you are arriving before or after the rally days. We (Approach Consulting, LLC) are working directly with the resort to schedule people's stays. You will only pay for the rally fees at the time of registration. If you are arriving more than 1 week prior, or staying more than 1 week after, we will notify the resort. In either case, we (Approach Consulting, LLC) will contact you via email to assure clear communication on how to complete the reservations. Note that if you are staying extra days, the per-night fee is \$93, and you will pay the resort for

those nights upon check-in to the rally. Those stays in excess of 1 week prior or after may be asked to pay a deposit by the resort.
